Sleep Apnea & Sleep Disorders after the first edition in Rome in 2022, returns with the second edition and moves to the beautiful city of Bari, from 14 to 16 September 2023, three days of training and information with an international flavour.

The first of the three days (14 September) is dedicated to institutional round tables in webinar mode non CME; the second and third days (15 and 16 September) will be dedicated to residential CME training. In addition, on the third day (16 September), a separate room will be set up for the participation of AAI members in residential mode non CME.

Obstructive Sleep Apnea is a pathology with a high social and epidemiological impact that involves about 4.5 million patients in Italy (with moderate to severe), of whom only 5% are diagnosed and undergoing treatment. In order to improve this figure, there are many initiatives to be launched: correct information. multi-disciplinary training, the creation and implementation of regional PDTAs, the strengthening of diagnosis and therapy on the territory, and lastly the importance of redesigning and involving all stakeholders in the tender specifications for medical devices. However, we must not forget the numerous comorbidities that patients develop and can coexist with OSA, such as COPD, severe asthma, insomnia, excessive daytime sleepiness, nasal polyposis, and comorbidities also with rare diseases. The conference represents a unique opportunity to discuss all these topics with some of the leading national and international specialists and representatives of the Respiratory Disease Patient Associations.
