- In the room dedicated to patients, we started the first session with a presentation by the AAI Vice President Mr. Mastrogiacomo who presented the ongoing activities. We continued with Prof. Marisa Bonsignore with a report on CPAP therapy and dr. Pierpaolo Prosperi explained how the CPAP should be managed correctly. Mr. Filippo Martone talked to us about Non-CPAP therapies and Dr. Ida di Giacinto closed the first session talking to us about the anesthetic management of OSA patients.
- In the 2nd session, we brought together in a round table on the participation of associations in health, the Director of the PAL Teresa Petrangolini (Patient advocacy Lab of ALTEMS - Univ, Sacro Cuore), Lorenzo Latella (Cittadinanzattiva Campania), Maria Rosaria di Somma (Executive Italian Association for Cardiac Compensation) and Luca Roberti (AAI).
- In the 3rd session we talked about Sleep Disorders and comorbidities with Prof. Puligheddu who told us about EDS, Dr. Morrone reported on Insomnia and cognitive behavioral therapy and Prof. Ferini Strambi closed the session with a report on RLS.





ECM accredited session for doctors and nurses for OSA adults/children

- In the rooms dedicated to ECM training for pediatric and adult medical specialists, the major national specialists and the specialists of the Lazio Region who have worked over the years in the subgroups for the drafting of the Regional Diagnostic Therapeutic Patchways.
- The reports highlighted the importance of the multidisciplinary approach for the integrated management of patients, both in children and adults. Similar paths have as their common denominator the strengthening of the territorial clinics, the 1st level DRS Centers. The importance of involving the family Pediatrician and the General Practitioner also emerges as the first sentinel to identify patients early.
- We then listened, in the various reports, to the importance of phenotyping, the therapies available to specialists, the comorbidities related to the adult patient and the new possible drug therapies.
